

# Good Hope Farms Meeting

## November 8, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Jack Urling at 8 p.m. Jack Urling, Teri Guelcher, Melissa Shunk, Tina Antonicelli and Tracy Polovick were present.

The agenda was approved as presented.

The Sept. 13, 2010 minutes were approved as presented.

Teri Guelcher presented the treasurer's report. There is \$3,583.38 in the checking account. The only extraordinary expense for September and October was \$471.80 for deposit on the sign refurbishment by Hannaman Sign Crafters. There is \$235.60 in savings and \$3,126.59 in the CD. It will mature on April 11, 2011.
