

Good Hope Farms Meeting

September 13, 2010

Shunk House, 503 Kentwood

The meeting was called to order by Jack Urling at 8 p.m. Jack Urling, Teri Guelcher, Melissa Shunk, Deb Kozlovac, Kristi Bolden, Tina Antonicelli and Tracy Polovick were present.

The agenda was approved as presented.

There were no minutes from the June block party meeting.

Teri Guelcher presented the treasurer's report. There is \$4,850 in the checking account. About \$3,000 remains in the CD. There have been no extraordinary expenses. Membership is up, and we did a good job with expenses for the block party.

Monument – Jack Urling discovered that Hannaman Sign Crafters was the company that made the sign. It will cost \$943 to refurbish it. He is also working with Highland Gardens about replacing the shrubs around the monument.

There was a discussion regarding succession when Jack Urling moves. Teri Guelcher will assume the presidency, but someone needs to be found to be treasurer.

Welcoming – Tracy Polovick reported a few houses have been sold and she will visit them in the near future.
