

Good Hope Farms Civic Association Meeting
May 9, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Teri Guelcher at 8 p.m. Teri Guelcher, Jan Gibas, Shani Schalles, Kristi Bolden, Ty Poppe, Tiffany Young, Suzanne Bruzga and Tracy Polovick were present.

The agenda was approved as presented.

The March 7, 2011, minutes were approved as presented.

Jan Gibas presented the treasurer's report. There is \$235.88 in the savings account and \$1,900.31 in the checking account. The 18-month Certificate Account has \$3,148.67.
